What is the Carbon Footprint?


The purpose of carrying out a greenhouse gas emissions assessment is to evaluate the quantity of greenhouse gases released into the atmosphere by human activities and in particular by companies.

Article L 229-25 of the French Environment Code makes it compulsory for private-sector legal entities employing more than 500 people in mainland France and 250 people in overseas France to draw up a Bilan Carbone every four years.


GYS situation to date:

The company's Carbon Footprint has been carried out for the year 2021 using the Bilan Carbone® tool - version 8.8 from the Association Bilan Carbone (ABC), which enables the regulatory obligation to be met in full.

GYS commitment:

Following this assessment, various actions have been undertaken. Over 4 years, they will enable us to reduce our carbon impact by at least 25.74 t CO2eq.
